FAIRMOUNT PARK IS LOOKING FOR A FEW GOOD HOLIDAY TREES

Fairmount Park needs evergreen trees to be used for two highly visible locations in the city. On behalf of the City of Philadelphia, Fairmount Park staff has the honor and distinction of erecting the official holiday trees at City Hall and The Philadelphia Museum of Art.

A tree specialist will inspect each tree for suitability and notify the owner if it is up to standards. Trees should measure 40 to 60 feet in height. Preferred trees include spruce, pine and fir. Trees selected will be carefully removed in tact by trained, experienced professionals at no cost to the owner.
